

# **Quality Disclaimer**

# EqualPBT (qPBT for short) produces affordable sets of PBT keycaps featuring original designs.

qPBT produces PBT keycaps using a method called dye sublimation. This means legends and keycap colors are printed onto blank caps.

There are many upsides to producing keycaps this way (speed of the prototyping and production process being one of them). And even though we strive to ship the highest quality products, some issues might arise.

#### Side Fading

Depending on the background color of the caps, some slight fading might happen on the side of the caps, in corners, or around homing bars.

#### **Inconsistent Colors**

Shades might show subtle differences between keys.

#### **Blue Tint**

Black keys might have a slightly blue-ish tint in certain lighting conditions.

#### **Rough Edges**

The bottom edge of the caps might show some spruce marks. If you want, you can carefully remove these yourself with the help of a sharp knife.

#### **Crooked Keys**

Some keys might have a slight issue with their stem which causes them to sit slightly crooked or off-center.

## **Legend Alignment**

Legends might look slightly out of place or rotated.

#### **Wall Warping**

Keys can have their walls warped inwards slightly. This is normal and shouldn't impede their functionality.

#### Slightly Warped Spacebars

Longer keys such as spacebars might appear slightly bent. This shouldn't prevent it from performing as expected.

## **Scratches & Spots**

Some keys might have what look like scratches or spots on them. Most of these will fade after some use.
